CALL FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO PARTICIPATE IN 2ND REGIONAL SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS LEADERSHIP AND ADVOCACY TRAINING WORKSHOP

15 -21 April 2012.

There is a dire need for young people particularly young women to respond to the provisions and guidelines of national and regional policies and frameworks such as Maputo Plan of Action, Protocol on Gender and Development, African Charter on Human & People's Rights, Continental Policy Framework on Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) and the Protocol to the African Charter on the Rights of Women.

Partners in Sexual Health (PSH) intend to provide training to young women and men on SRHR leadership. The project, funded by Ford Foundation, will capacitate and mentor young women and men already working and knowledgeable in the field of SRHR within Southern Africa, with Advocacy & Leadership skills to address issues affecting young people, and thus promote the implementation of policies and programmes that will particularly benefit young people.

PSH therefore calls on all interested young people to respond to this advert in writing on or before 24 February 2012 to Petronella, e-mail address: petronella@psh.org.za or admin@psh.org.za . The criteria for selection to the programme are as follows:

- ◆ The candidate should write a short letter of motivation as to why s/he should be selected into the programme
- ◆ The candidate needs to submit a letter of support for post training activities from his/her organisation.
- ◆ Candidate is required to have a strong SRH background
- ◆ He/ she should have a post-matric qualification, such as a diploma or first degree.
- ◆ Candidate should demonstrate leadership qualities
- ◆ Candidate is required to possess good communications skills, written and verbal
- ◆ Candidate should be computer literate.
- ◆ Candidate should be prepared to provide a detailed presentation on the status of SRHR in their countries. (Guiding documents will be provided.)
- ◆ The prospective candidates should also be prepared to complete a 1-week training programme in South Africa
- ◆ The successful candidates are required to complete an e learning course on SRHR prior to the training.
